

BLOOMINGDALE RIVERWALK INFORMATION SESSION

The Borough of Bloomingdale is undertaking a feasibility study for a Riverwalk adjoining the Pequannock River on the south side of Paterson Hamburg Turnpike. The study has been funded by Passaic County and the Riverwalk will achieve the following benefits to the Borough:

- Conserve environmentally sensitive areas (steep slopes, wildlife habitat, flood plain)
- Preserve the Pequannock River ecosystem and provide a passive recreation opportunity with linkage to local businesses
- Foster the desirability of and improvements to Central Business District parcels by linking them to a shared Riverwalk amenity
- Promote visits to the borough's Central Business District and connect visitors to the River and passive recreation
- Entice businesses to locate in the Borough to fill in existing gaps in goods and services

The Borough is evaluating the physical constraints to a continuous Riverwalk. The Riverwalk may be a combination of linkages, based on the existing constraints.
